

A Divine Message of Hope and Love
What Are You Willing to Lose, to Gain?
A Divine Milepost?

During my time with the Lord this morning, I asked if He would like to share something with His people at this website? It was when I had completed the writing that He, through the Holy Spirit gave me, 12/5/2020, that I understood the great importance of the message He had to share, but also that it could be a Divine Milepost (marker) as to where we are in our current wilderness journey.

First, the writing: “Debbie, Do you hear Me? Do you hear Me, Debbie? Do you really, really hear Me? Now is the time to put away all malice, pain from other’s actions/inactions, hurt that is carried in one’s heart, suffering caused at the hands of others, misunderstandings, miscommunications, mishaps, misery that one carries as a result of another’s actions/inactions, sorrow carried as a result of losses due to other’s actions/inactions, heart break as a result of unrequited actions/inactions on the part of others. It is a time to let go of all that you carry in your heart that causes you to be imprisoned by the chains that others have placed on you. It is time for you to emerge filled with love for those who have wronged you or you perceive have wronged you. There is no room for envy, jealousy, or lusting after what others have. It is time for hearts to be scourged and cleansed of all that causes My people to be tethered in bondage to this world system.

It is time for you to see what you never thought possible could happen and in the midst of all the chaos, confusion, and even destruction and devastation, My people will rise with hearts purified, cleansed, and ready to be filled with My love and My ways to live their lives more abundantly. What good is it if a man loses his soul to gain the whole world? This is the way of those of your nation who are filled overflowing with Deception. The way of My people is to lose the whole world and gain their life lived more abundantly. **What are you willing to lose, Debbie, to gain?** To follow Me, to become one I call friend, one must be willing to separate oneself from the world’s ways in order to discover My ways. This is what you know to be true, Debbie? You did so long ago.”

After I received this writing, I remembered that I had been given a previous writing much like this one - one that was specifically designed for me, at the end of my wilderness journey - 3 months before I would enter into my “Promised Land,” where I would “possess my land”/my life and live the way the Lord had taught me in my own wilderness time. Since I have had my own wilderness journey, with that understanding, I decided to seek in the Bible where the Israelites were asked the same question as I had been asked and that the Lord is asking here: “What are you willing to lose, to gain?” I knew it had to be near the end of their wilderness journey and that is where I found Deuteronomy 11: 26-28 where they are given a choice of choosing between “blessings or a curse.” I believe that is what we are being given at this point in our journey. If we want the blessings then we will choose what the Lord has outlined for us here. I believe as we move into our “Promised Land,” it will be by loving God with our whole, heart, mind, and soul, and as Jesus commanded us in John 13:34&35 NCV: “I give you a new command: Love each other. God’s system is based on Love and Need as I shared in the very first message I posted at this website - “Hope, Treasure, and Josiah.” Each of us has something in us that another needs and vice versa.
