If we are “crisis thinkers,” we must consider changing from paying double payments on mortgages and credit cards and consider paying minimum payments and using the cash to prepare. But it truly takes thinking a different way than we have been programmed; it takes a change in “mindset.” If we wait until after the crisis, good luck with finding what you need – and you won’t be the only one looking – it won’t be safe. We never, ever put our home in jeopardy by taking more than we can pay back; we just gather in what is already available and put it in our care and do with it what we need for God’s Kingdom. We don’t know when the crisis will happen, but God does and if we ask, He will direct and guide us and help us find what we need to prepare. We have been so programmed to be a nation of individuals that are so independent, but that is not God’s way – He desires for us to seek Him in everything we do – not a dependence on Him that leaves us captive/paralyzed in fear, but hearing His voice and choosing to follow Him, knowing that He knows much better how to help us than we know how to help ourselves and in turn His Kingdom flourishes. * Silver is easier to buy/sell with in crisis. (Silver American Eagles) 1 oz. is currently worth about \$18.00—varies constantly.

20 Silver Eagles come in a tube. 25 tubes (500 Coins = “Monster Box”)
