

***EMBRACING OUR HEAVENLY HOME
IN THESE DIFFICULT TIMES !!!***

In the early 90's, before the stresses devastated my life, I had the opportunity of listening to a wonderful program on our local Christian Radio Station, WPRZ, entitled, "Lifetime Guarantee," hosted by a married couple, Dr. Bill Gillham and his wife, Anabel. They were both wonderful teachers and my husband and I had the opportunity of attending a Bible study through video tapes (this is back in the ancient times) their ministry provided. We both can recall, to this day, understandings that they provided to us. They both had a special way of relaying God's love and truth. One thing I remember Dr. Gillham, a psychologist, saying that we were "Spirit Critters in Earth Suits," and another truth that gave me such great strength as I found myself later at the bottom of my pit of despair was that "we were all a 10 in God's eyes; we couldn't be more or we couldn't be less - we were 100% accepted by God." (I add the scale being 1 through 10.) When I designed my Compassion Warriorette figure illustrating the Full Armor of God as in Ephesians 6:13-18 (from Deprogramming and Reprogramming our Hearts, Minds, and Souls located at this website,) I remembered and included those words in describing the "helmet of salvation."

So, as Dr. Gillham would teach, we are "Spirit Critters in Earth Suits." He would go on to share that we were in Earth suits that were constantly decaying and one day we would eject from them and go back to our Home. So, how does that help me in times of difficulties you might ask? How does that help with all the difficulties that we have suffered thus far from Covid 19? First, let's look at Covid 19 from more of a Heavenly perspective. Covid 19 has been an interruption in our busy, busy, busy lives throughout the world - it has caused many of us to withdraw into isolation and seclusion for protection. When we read our Bibles, we learn that others throughout the Bible, like David, Moses, Abraham, and Joseph and many, many more also had their times in isolation and seclusion which was necessary for them to be readied/prepared to be/do what the Creator had created them to be/do. Looking from a Biblical perspective, isolation and seclusion is the place/the opportunity for the Creator to develop a closer and closer relationship with His creation once the ways and distractions of the world have been quieted and the creation can seek Him in ways they never knew to seek Him before.

On the other hand, Covid 19 has been a time of great stress, as folks have experienced lockdowns; lost their jobs, can't pay their mortgages, are consumed with financial worries - and some are even consumed about how to have money enough to buy food for their families, as well as food now has limits on what is available to purchase. At the same time, they may have faced tremendous losses of those they love - not even able to visit them in the hospital or even have a funeral. And, for others, how do they educate their children and keep the family safe at the same time? Hope has dwindled as the challenges seem overwhelming.

So, how do we have Hope in the midst of all these difficulties? In my writings*, the Lord instilled Hope in me as He shared with me, first by inviting me to the King's Palace, (and always providing descriptions through words,) and later, I would learn that the King's Palace was my Heavenly Home. Through the descriptions, I learned to embrace the beauty of my Heavenly Home and the closer and closer I grew in a relationship with the Lord, as I took each step in the wilderness journey, I realized what Dr. Gillham had shared with me so many years before, my true Home was in Heaven; this earthly home is only temporary. The Lord would also teach me through many, many writings (repetition) that "Life is for living - not Surviving." The difference is Hope. And, another truth He instilled in me through many, many writings (repetition) was "In each day, there may be difficulties and I have to face those difficulties/they must be addressed, but also in each day there is treasure to be sought and to find that treasure, I must seek it with my whole heart, mind, and soul." My greatest strength is - and no one can take it away from me - I know that God Loves Me!!! And, I hold as close to Him as I can get. I know that I am nothing and can do nothing without Him, but "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Philippians 4:13

In Revelation 21, we can read about Heaven coming to Earth. How magnificent - it is so difficult to imagine - but it is there for us to read about - all the splendor and purity. But as I contemplated what to share with you, I wanted to share, again, from the "Path to Overflowing Hope; the New Day," some of the descriptions that the Lord has shared with me of the King's Palace and of Home so you can, too, embrace the images of Hope of this most magnificent place - our Heavenly Home and our Heavenly Father's desires.

From the first one of 10/31/1998, "... Come to my palace. You've been invited. Gaze at the beautiful lights; stroll down My Golden Corridors. I've asked you here for a reason. I asked you here as my guest. I want to share with you all that I love. And watch your eyes light up with joy and hope..." (This was midpoint of my wilderness journey; it was a very difficult time.)

Some descriptions have been formed in my thoughts from my writings; others are directly from my writings. Here we go: As you enter into the King's Palace, looking up, there is a beautiful/magnificent Chandelier. The Chandelier is like a tree upside down made of gold branches and diamonds like leaves of a tree. It is powered by God's love—no other power source in the Palace. And God's love/light is so powerful there are no shadows—everything is exposed to light.

The way the Chandelier operates is God's love/light is caught by the prism/diamond and that one reflects to another and that one to another and so on and so on until the entire Chandelier lights up. From a writing dated 1/14/2011: "It is a perfect reflection for their sides are smooth and pure without blemish and deception or encumbrance. This is the way man's heart has been created. But due to pain, bitterness, and deception, man's heart has become hidden and shadowed. My power is not able to be reflected. When it is caught, it is skewed by traditions, by strongholds/defenses, addictions and deceptions. What was pure and meant for good of My Kingdom is distorted and used in a way never meant to be. I have sought to limit what I very much desire to give My people..."

After all that I have been shown, I realize the Chandelier represents the way God desires to light up the world with His love—reflecting His love from one heart to another. Not refracted light through our heart's filters, but His love reflected through our pure hearts to others as He intends.

From the entry, we enter into the Corridor of Faith and Trust. As we saw in the first writing, it is a golden corridor with golden walls with images, like pictures, etched in platinum and gold, of faces. These are the faces of just ordinary men and women (like you and I) who when faced with the most difficult circumstances, through the empowerment of God's love, became extraordinary—the overcomers of their day.

From the Golden Corridor of Faith and Trust, we enter into the Great Room of Hope. It is huge with a very long table. At the table I was seated, are the saints, old and new, who "speak of events in the past and those yet to come." from 10/23/13. There was a special place for me to sit in front of a place setting reserved just for me. There was no food on the plate before me, but there were three goblets/cups. I was shown one was filled with pain and one with suffering and I had to take sips from time to time for that is of "life of this world," but the third was filled with God's love and I could gorge on it. And when I had finished drinking all I was given, Jesus, Himself, stepped up and gave me a re-fill to the brim. In one writing, at the table when I first was given the description, there were folks there who seemed gnarled and emaciated and I was shown that those folks only drank from the two cups, pain and suffering, and only sipped occasionally from God's love.

Outside the Great Room of Hope—From a writing 7/32/2010: “Enter through the gate, Beautiful. You have now entered the grounds of My Palace. The grounds are covered in blues and greens, yellows and pinks, purples and even vivid reds—all the colors of the rainbows. These colors are vibrant and full of vitality. They exist for pleasure and delight. Each has a fragrance given each one and produced by the stems that produce the petals. In My Kingdom, is no death. Everything has a purpose for which it was created and fulfills that purpose. If a petal is plucked, it lives on continuing to provide fragrance and beauty wherever it goes and a new petal emerges to fulfill its purpose ... You see, I am the Creator of the Universe but I take great delight in creating My creations—as an artist who delights in filling a blank canvas with color and shapes; designs to fit one with another to form beauty, form, fit, and function as only an artist can When I look upon the Earth, I see a garden of My creations. They vary in color; each one with a specific purpose to fulfill in My Kingdom—never meant to die, but live eternal life with Me in Heaven. **They are My children, but they have lost touch with their Creator....**”

And then there is the River. From my writing 4/5/2011 “On each side of the River are golden pathways lined with trees that are fed by the river. The trees are tall and their roots grow deep. They glisten like glass and the branches reach upward. As the gentle wind flows through their branches, the trees sing a song of Hope and Thankfulness. In My Kingdom, all creations sing. It is as they have been created. As you travel down the path by the river, the river will also reveal its true nature in song of Hope and Thankfulness as it flows and provides refreshment to My creations. My creations were designed with a song in their hearts of Hope and Thankfulness. It is when all is stripped away of deception and addiction and their true nature is revealed, My children will sing It is impossible for My creations, once they do/be what they were created to do/be, to not sing—it is as they have been created.”

So, my King’s Palace writings stopped in 2011. I was given no more descriptions of the Palace. However, on May 6, 2011 from my writing: “Look Up, Debbie. Look Up as far as you can see. Look up beyond the tallest mountain peak. Look up and up, further than the clouds. Continue, Up and Up. Keep looking Up. Do you see it in the distance? The King’s Palace—Home. Enter under the great chandelier of diamonds and gold powered only by the love of Your Heavenly Father. Stroll down the corridor of Faith and Trust and gaze at each face of the overcomers etched in gold and platinum. A place setting is waiting for you at the King’s Table in the Great Room of Hope. Gathered around are the Saints, new and old. They are chatting about the things to come. As you listen, you will hear much that you do not know. They have been to places you must go. ...Debbie, this is your home. This is where you are most at home. This is where you belong. This is where you find strength and comfort. This is where you are welcomed. This is your place –where only you sit. This is the place you can come and walk in the garden or by the stream that flows along the path. This is your place to run to when all seems too overwhelming. It’s the place that has what you find lacking. When life as you have lived it ceases, find comfort knowing there is a place of security and peace that you can run to. Find comfort in knowing the Creator of the Universe has invited you to the King’s Palace. Find comfort that you can always find peace there as you visit what has become familiar. The King’s Palace is the place of peace and strength. It is a place that has been given to you as a refuge in times of difficulties. It is a place for treasure hunting; it is not an escape, it is a place where what seems impossible is proved to be possible.”

To close, I once met a man who carried a letter of hate in his wallet written by a family member. We must have been chatting about our families and he opened his wallet and started to pull out a letter, years old, worn and tattered; an example of the pain he carried in his heart. I declined to read the letter, but I asked him if he would accept a gift from me. I gave him a little laminated card, like copies we have shared with you here: <http://jubilee.com/JesusWalletCardsRev-.pdf> to put beside the letter and when he pulled the letter out if he would pull out the card as well, an example of how much God loved him. What we share at this website is what we have been given to share. We know that difficulties are coming - far more difficult than those we have faced thus far. But we also know there is Hope, Overflowing. We know where to find it. We have to deal with the difficulties, and our Heavenly Father will help us with those when we seek Him with our whole Hearts, Minds, and Souls. But, we also can set our minds on Heaven above - not fixate on this temporary earthly home, but on our Home in Heaven. We can embrace it! And, we don’t have to die to do so. But also, don’t become so attached to Heaven that you want to take yourself there/suicide, remember what Paul wrote: Philippians 1:23. God has work for you to do here!

During my wilderness journey, I first made a card that I carried with me (I laminated it and attached it to my belt when I went out) that at the top said: "God Loves Me." It contained the 12 Truths that I call the "God Given Rights" from "Deprogramming and Reprogramming our hearts, minds, and souls" found at this website.

At that time, I was so fragile that any perceived negative emotion from others could cause me to suffer great difficulties. But the card always reminded me of God's love and His truth. When difficulties came, I could reach for the card and become calm as I began reading God's truth about me. I then decided the same would be a help to others and designed these little cards for others to carry with them. There is one with Hope scriptures, one of Trust, one of Promise. There is a card to share with others to help them come to ask the Lord into their hearts. We have added one with a picture of our interpretation of Heaven, painted from descriptions taken from one of my writings. They are easily cut out and folded in the middle and can be tucked away in your wallet or a secret place for you to have whenever you need them. They are yours to be shared as you desire to empower you and others, but they are never to be sold. We hope these will be as much help to you as they have been especially to me.
