

Welcome to this section of our Web Site. I have so much that I would love to share with you, but I have found if someone with more credibility than I has said something, then it is best to share what they have said and credit them for saying it, rather than me trying to explain. With that understanding, I have over 40 lbs of paper of writings with the first writing given to me in 1998. And, by the way, you were in that writing. I will share with you more about that later, but first I have something to share with you from someone you know very well and He loves you very much. It is from one of my writings from 9/5/2008—over 10 years ago.

Debbie: “Lord, I so desire to hear from you today. Lord, I realize I am not comfortable in relating with people. I know what I need to do; I just find it difficult making it happen.”

The Lord’s response: “Do you know me, Debbie? Do you know me? Do you really, really know me? Know I know you. Today all you know about life is a step from changing. All (the ways) that you, as well as others, have grown accustomed to living is changing. Securities, Dreams, Hopes, Positions, and Titles will be changing.

The leaders of your nation boast of change. The people cry out that they want change. And in their midst a change is coming. Change that will rise from the ashes of what once was the way they lived their lives. Change that will not only affect their way of life, but will affect the foundations of their souls. Change that will not be long in coming, but will happen as a result of the worst day in your nation’s history. Change that is not brought about by election, but change that comes forth from destruction. Change of the heart. Change of the mind. Change of one’s entire well being. Change not that any man can boast. Change that provokes and invokes the very nature of man.

When Change comes to your nation, it must first come to men’s hearts. It is not your country that lacks, nor men as they were created, it is the corruptness of men’s hearts that causes the lack in what is the most prosperous and protected and providential nations.

Change will come swiftly, harshly, and deliberately. Those who speak of Change will not welcome its coming; they will not be prepared. They will look for ways to escape; to protect their old ways; to not be drowned in its midst. Change was their cry for battle, but will leave them as deserters, running to and fro seeking what no longer exists. The true Believers will be the ones who know in the midst of Change is chaos and confusion. Out of the deepest and darkest of times, a NEW DAY is birthed. Change is about not looking back and mourning what doesn’t exist, but embracing the future; a NEW DAY with new purpose, possibilities and potential. Change is not the same old ways packaged in new trappings, but embracing truth and living life as it was intended, by the leading of the Holy Spirit; allowing/welcoming the cleansing/purification of one’s Heart in order to do the will of the Father.”

To share further with you what the Lord shared with me that prompted us to add this segment, I have to go back to the beginning of my journey. It started with a miscarriage and then another miscarriage 6 months later and 9 months later a hospital stay where I was given a diagnosis of Manic Depression and was told the medication that best fit my illness could damage a baby's heart. I now believe it was the tremendous stress as a result of the lack of understanding of the workings of the world's ways and all the Personalities' Strongholds/Defenses/Deceptions/Addictions (S/D/D/A,) mine and others', that over time took its toll on my body and led to all this pain. I was left in a Hopeless state, with helplessness, worthlessness, and uselessness as companions, as I plummeted into a pit of despair where I discovered that when one loses Hope, one ceases the desire to be on this planet.

I had never realized till a few days ago that I carried in me feelings of life failures including losing my little babies—they were both only a couple weeks into my pregnancies. And I remembered one night I was reading a book because I couldn't sleep—you see I had been to the doctor, it was the 2nd baby, and the doctor had prepared me that I was probably going to lose the baby. The measurements used to determine if the baby was thriving were low and we would watch to see if the counts increased or decreased. That entire week, I begged and pleaded with God to let me keep my baby. If the counts did decrease, I knew that He could turn it all around, that I could have my baby, and what a great testimony of His love. Time went by and the truth revealed that the worst of my fears came true and I needed a procedure to have any remains removed or I might hemorrhage and could die—we lived well over an hour from the hospital. But I refused to have the procedure. I felt if I did have the procedure then God would see it as a lack of Faith and my baby would be denied. I was a fairly new Christian of less than two years. Anyway, that night I was reading a book and in it was the passage from John 9:3 about the Blind Boy. Jesus says, "it wasn't the sin of the mother; it wasn't the sin of the father, but it was for the Glory of God." And I cried out inside, "How could "this" ever be for the Glory of God." I thought the book I was reading at the time was "Disappointment with God," by Philip Yancey, but that was in 1991. Anyway, a night or two later, I had the most unbelievable dream. I still can recall the details and the bright and vivid colors today. The setting was a stall and a sheep who was having trouble delivering her baby lamb. She was in great distress. I saw two hands emerge with surgeon type gloves that helped her. She delivered her lamb, but it did not move. And as a gloved hand moved from the top of the head toward the tail of the listless/lifeless little lamb, revealed was the most beautiful/plush lamb's coat—so soft and white and pure and perfect—but the little lamb did not move and the Momma Sheep was in such distress and agony because of her loss. I surrendered. I had the procedure. That brings us to today.

My sister-in-law, in another state, sent me an email joyously announcing as a grandmother does that she had just become a grandmother for another time. I was delighted for her and my niece—a beautiful baby boy they named Josiah. But then the grief started to surface—I know nothing of being a mother; I will never know the joys of being a grandmother; all I know is the pain associated with not having a child and especially in this society—the pain of isolation and seclusion as having nothing in common with any of the women my age in addition to my illness. And the Lord showed me I had always seen my miscarriages as my failures and that was as the ways of the world. In addition, I perceived everyone saw me as a failure. So the Lord began a work in my heart.

After my husband saw my grief and upon his request, I gave our babies from 1991 names. I called one Hope and one Treasure. Why the names? Hope is given her name because we found out at the time we were losing her, while we were in the emergency room, that we could have a baby. We had been married for 7 years and had never gotten pregnant. So in the midst of the worst of our circumstances, our little Hope showed us there was a path to a treasure we had not discovered and that we didn't even know existed.

So, why the name Treasure? Because even though the Lord denied my plea, He showed me in a way that only I could receive through a dream that was so beautiful and loving and amazing how much He loved me and it put me on a journey path of seeking and gathering in treasure that only He could provide as in tidbits of knowledge and morsels of understanding as I could receive them and that is what is shared in this website with you today. You see, in the midst of the worst of circumstances we found Hope, but then Hope led us to another path called Treasure. And Treasure opened up the way for us to truly know the Heart of God. You see, I had always seen this devastation and pain in my life from the world's ways perspective; I had never seen how God took that pain and sorrow and turned it around for the good of His Kingdom—even for you.

So, I wanted desperately to find the passage in the book I had read over a couple decades ago. I thought it was "Disappointment with God," by Philip Yancey which I had read about that time, but after reading every page of the over 300 page book, I didn't find the passage I was looking for. I did find a reference, but it wasn't the book. But what I did discover was what the Lord, I believe, wanted me to share with you today. It has always been a great burden of mine. In his book, there are three questions posed throughout which are brought about by pain and suffering: "Is God unfair?" "Is God silent?" "Is God hidden?" And I will add another from an American Association of Christian Counselor's (AACC) teaching series titled "Heal Our Land." This teaching came about as the best of the best Christian counselors gathered to minister/encourage and refresh the first responder counselors who were ministering to those who suffered on 9/11. I remember one teaching by Beth Moore, speaker and author, including the author of one of my favorite Bible Studies: "A Woman's Heart: God's Dwelling Place," and AACC speaker that day where she explained that folks/Christians denied even the existence of God because if there was a God, He would have never allowed what happened to them on 9/11/2001. You see, I believe the problem is Christians in our nation today have been programmed with the health/wealth/prosperity form of understanding. And what I conclude is they can't see that God wants willing vessels that He can use for His purposes and plans. We have to be rid of the world's ways just as the Israelites, and we have to be willing to embrace God's ways—and that is a process—a very, very painful process (our selfish self-centered natures are driven by the world's ways.) What most of us have been taught is that it is all about God supplying us with all our wants and needs, when in fact our focus should be all about Him—about His desires and needs and how He can use us, as emptied vessels to be filled to the brim by Him to achieve His plans and His desires; for us to do His will for His glory. And that is why the writing about "Change."

So, during this time, I also had two questions I didn't understand. To address the first, anyone who looks at the website, will have discovered Strongholds/Defenses/Deceptions/Addictions (S/D/D/A) which are a result of our selfish self-centered natures which Paul writes so much about in the New Testament. My question is how do folks give up these natures? I understand when the world's system/ways of the world collapse as a result of "Change," these natures will remain intact. But what the Lord revealed to me is there are two systems. There is the world's ways which operates with paychecks, money, materialism, power, title, position, greed and holds us captive. Then there is God's ways which operates on Love and Need. So that brings me to the 2nd question. The Late John Paul Jackson taught there would be great breakthroughs in technology and medicine, etc. If there is a crisis (the world system collapses), how can that be? (Note, if we go back to the technology of the 1880's, we go there with the mindset of today with the understanding and knowledge, and brilliant minds of today with the leading and guidance of the Holy Spirit to bring us into the New Day.) John Paul Jackson taught that those who live at this time all were given, by God, something inside of them that fulfilled a need of another. You might see this as a "Love your Neighbor as Yourself" system. As we let go of our S/D/D/A and come to the level to meet and fulfill the need of our neighbor, we are, ourselves, more than fulfilled—no need for S/D/D/A.

You see, God's system is based on Love and Need. So, why would God allow the devastation and destruction? He is such a loving God who cares so much for His children. I believe the writing about "Change" answers that question. But I want to give you something else to think about. What if we are really at the times of Jacob's Trouble as John Paul Jackson taught. He referred to Jeremiah 30 and Psalm 24. What if there was a New World Order and we were all attached to the electric grid and we knew nothing about being self sufficient. Then, we would all probably have to go down and sign up for what the TV Pastors teach as the mark of the beast. This is total speculation and I have nothing in my writings, only that God says He has a plan. But what if God used the crisis that is coming to "wean" us from the power grid and teach those who survived the crisis to live His ways. I want you to know the Lord showed me a couple years ago that "Deprogramming and Reprogramming our Hearts and Minds and Souls" teaches us how to "Love One Another as we Love Ourselves" and "the Path to Overflowing Hope," teaches us to Seek and to "Love the Lord your God with all your Heart, Mind, and Soul, both, as Jesus commanded us to do (Matthew 22:38&39.) Maybe this will give clarity, from a portion of a writing from 8/18/2018, "Continue the path before you. Build up your storehouses. Secure your gates. Harvest the energy of the Sun. Top off every tank that holds fluid. It is time to strengthen, repair, build, and secure all you have Watch like you have never seen before. The riders will mount up their horses once more, having been unable to meet the terms of another. This time there will be no stopping." I believe we should keep a watchful eye out for NK.

So, in conclusion I wanted to let you know as I mentioned in the first paragraph, you were in my first writing in October, 1998. I was shown that I would train Compassion Warriors and Warriorettes. I have shared with you the meaning of what is shared and if you have read this then you know you are very special. As the late John Paul Jackson would quote, "you were born for such a time as this." Print out a copy of all that is here. Your computer may not work or the Website may not be available after a crisis. And, I have provided for you an audio, with added information, of a video teaching the Lord has had us prepare for after the crisis. The people who read what the Lord has given me to share are not a people who criticize or fault find or ridicule, they are a great people who seek as I have sought to find the Heart of God—not for fear or for duty, just because they love Him and want to know everything they can about Him. And remember the lessons of Hope and Treasure. In the midst of the worst of circumstances, always look for Hope and when you do you will find Treasure because the greatest Treasure of all is that God Loves You. No matter what your eyes see, no matter what your ears hear, no matter what your body experiences—whatever you go through, know that God will never leave you nor forsake you and most of all: God has a plan and if you look closely, you will find He has shared a great deal of it with you at this, Jubilee's website. Whatever happens, He will turn it around for the good of His people and in turn they will Glorify Him because for no other reason, they love Him and they will share from one heart to another until there are no more hearts to receive. This is how, simply put, that I have found His system works—Love and Need. Note: It wasn't till I was proofreading that I recalled the story of King Josiah. Please read 2 Kings 22&23.
