From John 8:32 NCV: “So Jesus said to the Jews who believed in him, “If you continue to obey my teaching, you are truly my followers. Then you will know the truth. And the truth will make you free.”” And from

John 8:36 NCV: “So if the Son makes you free, then you will be truly free.” And from my writing* dated 7/30/2003, 16 years ago—a defining moment for me, “You are free, Debbie, to see the truth. The truth may hurt and may not come in a pretty package, but Debbie you can see the truth. You would never be able to help others without seeing the truth; the truth that is clear of all encumbrances; the truth that is clear as the sky is blue and the grass is green; the truth that is as innocent as a baby’s smile. Mothers cry for children out of control and too young to know what is right and best—making mistakes with overreaching consequences.

You see, as you gaze out your window you do not see the disasters and crises that happen every day. I hear weeping; families crying for children who have been lost/trapped by lies—promising Hope but only bringing Heart Break.
