

## ***WHY?***

### ***From the Perspective of the Creator and the Creation!***

Covid-19 came as a surprise event. In all the writings the Lord has given me through the Holy Spirit, over 40 lbs. of yellow tablet paper, never once was a Covid-19 pandemic shared with me. Now, many, many times I have written and shared with you in previous website articles that an event, “when life as lived it ceases” was to occur and the description beginning with an EMP and a radiation event, but never was a Covid-19 event ever revealed. Was it necessary for the Creator to prepare us, the creation, for such a time. No. We were already prepared since we had been preparing for the event “when life as lived it ceases.” So, is there anything that we can learn during this time—in other words, why would the creator allow such a time? I decided to look to see if I could find an answer. My search took me to JOB and I was surprised what I found.

In Job 1:1 MEV, we learn that Job was “blameless and upright, fearing God and avoiding evil.” We then read how Job lived a “righteous” life. Then we come to Job 1:10—11. From God’s perspective: Job 1:8, “...there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and an upright man, who fears God, and avoids evil,” even calling Job His “servant.” This is a challenge/test between Satan and God—God has total trust and faith in His creation, Job, but as we read, Job will suffer greatly throughout the time of trial and testing. So, Why? To understand, we must also see that God set the parameters from which Satan could test Job 1:12 MEV, “... do not stretch out your hand against his person” and Job 2:6 MEV, “Very well, he is in your hand, but spare his life.” So, why does God allow this? He has said that Job is “blameless and upright, fearing God and avoiding evil.” It was when I re-read the book of Job that I found something I had never discovered before. In Job 42:5, MEV, Job is now responding to the Lord and says: **“I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear, but now my eyes sees You.”** You see, there is another scripture that addresses this same concept, Deuteronomy 29: 2—4 MEV in which Moses is sharing with the Israelite people as they begin their journey into the Promised Land—they are on the edge of the Jordan River. “Moses proclaimed to all Israel, and said to them: You have seen all that the Lord did before your eyes in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh and all his servants and to all his land—the great temptations which your eyes have seen, those signs and great wonders. **Yet to this day the Lord has not given you a heart to know, eyes to see and ears to hear.**” What was it—what changed that Job, who God, Himself, called His “servant” “blameless and upright...” and the Israelites who had seen the pillar of fire by night and the cloud by day that led them, as well as all the other miracles, did not understand until the end of the difficulties. I believe they knew of God—He was with them, but they didn’t KNOW Him; they didn’t trust Him and have Faith in Him and Love Him. Their eyes had been opened in a way they never knew before. I believe that is the perspective that the creation does not understand as it endures the difficulties and the hardships of the wilderness journey. The creation is left not understanding “why” would this loving Heavenly Father allow this to happen to me? It is through the difficulties and the wilderness that we grow closer and closer in a relationship with the Creator of the Universe and therefore become stronger and stronger—able to fulfill our purpose to be/do as the creation, what the Creator has created us to be/do as shared in “the Path to Overflowing Hope” found at this website.

To answer the question I posed at the first of this article, I believe this is a time of preparation for a much more difficult time coming. If we have stayed within the parameters that have been set for this testing time, we will be safe and well. But that will have required us to have prepared in advance. Even though this time of isolation has been difficult for many, imagine a time when there is no social media, no media at all, no cell phone, no grocery stores, no electricity, etc. This is the time that we have been preparing for: “when life as lived it ceases.” It is in this present time that we can learn to prepare for the more difficult time that is coming. I don’t want to diminish in any way the suffering of others—it has been a great time of suffering, but we must prepare for a greater time of suffering.
